Building a digital safety net

Parental control apps

- Equip yourself with parental control apps to manage screen time and app access.
- With parental control apps, you can keep an eye on your child's online activities with ease!

How to setup parental control apps:

ANDROID

1. Open the Google Play app
2. Tap Profile icon > Settings > Family > Parental Controls
4. Turn on parental controls
5. Set up PIN for your parental controls
6. Select the type of content you want to filter
7. Choose how to filter or restrict access

iOS

1. Go to Settings and tap Screen Time.
2. Tap Content & Privacy Restrictions > Content Restrictions.
3. Choose the settings that you want for each feature or setting under **Allowed Store Content**. Here are the types of content that you can restrict: **Apps, Music, Books, TV Shows, etc.**

Navigating the digital maze

- Enable 'safe search' settings to act as your child's online compass, steering them clear of inappropriate content.
- To enable safe search, go to the settings of your web browser and find "Safe Search" or similar options.
- Set up content filters for apps and websites through the parental control app.
- If your child is under 13, create a Family Sharing account to manage their Apple ID.
